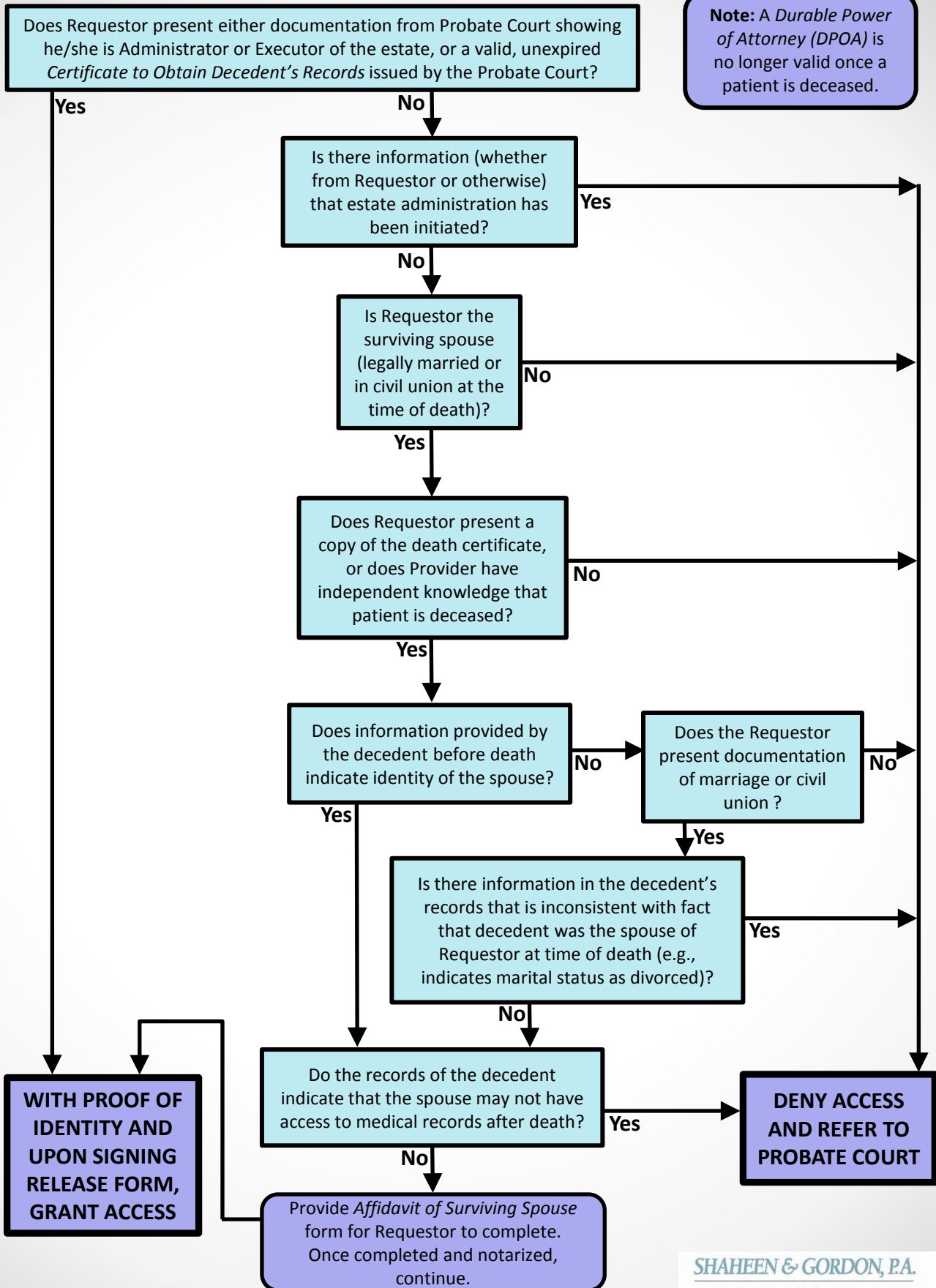


Release of Medical Records of a Deceased Patient (NH)
